How long is my term on the Board?

For a Student Governohne term on the Board can beep to two years.

What time commitment do I need to make to the Board?

- (a) Required
 - 3/4 Orientation session
 - 3/4 Approximately four (4) regular Board meetings per ye (anne day per meeting)
 - 3/4 FallBoard Development Sessicomeday).
 - ³⁄₄ Membership on one Board standing committee approximately four (4) meetings per year (½ day per meeting).
 - 3/4 Preparation time for committee and Board meetings
 - 3⁄4 Attendance at a convocation and other events if requested to represent the Board



- (b) Encouraged:
 - ³/₄ Voluntary attendance at as many College functions as possible (NOTE When attending events on <u>voluntary</u> basis, per diems are <u>n</u> applicable)
 - ³⁄₄ Participation in ad hoc committeets required.
