

## Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) Applications for a current student: Online Eligibility Questions

When you begin your application for a temporary resident visa from inside Canada, you will need to:

- 1. Log into or create an online IRCC account.
- 2. Go to , then select
- 3. Click on the blue button that says Visitor visa, study and/or work permit.
- 4. Respond to a series of "Eligibility Questions" so that the system can identify what type of application you need to submit. The below list is a guide to some of the appropriate answers for the eligibility questions. Please note that this is not a complete list and you should answer all questions as is accurate in your particular circumstances, if they differ from the recommendation below.

How long are you planning to stay in Canada?	Temporarily – more than 6 months
What is your current country/territory of residence?	Canada
Do you have a provincial attestation letter?	No. This is not a requirement for a temporary resident
	visa application.
Do you qualify for an exception?	Yes. This is in reference to exceptions to the
	requirement for the provincial attestation letter.
Which exception do you qualify for?	I am an applicant who meets another exception listed on
	the IRCC website (Study permit: Get the right documents
	<u>Provincial attestation letter or territorial attestation</u>
	<u>letter - Canada.ca</u> ).
What is your current immigration status in Canada?	Student
